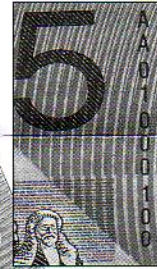

CONDITIONS AND DETAILS ARE SET OUT BELOW

- 1a. **Tender 1:** for sale are 400 specially numbered sheets of Australian Federation \$5 notes. Each sheet consists of 40 notes with a face value of \$200. As usual, the serial number prefix differs for each note on the sheet. The prefix range is AA 01 to DA 01. The numerical part of the serial number is the same for all notes on a given sheet. The numbers range from 000 501 to 000 999. To ensure good quality sheets from the normal production run, some sheets have been culled. This means that the sheet numbering is not consecutive. The following numbers are available starting with AA 01 000: 501-516, 519-533, 566-599, 600-610, 612-683, 714-719, 721-758, 767-794, 808-891, 893-899, 900-923, 925-964, 966-990. The signature combination is I.J Macfarlane and E.A. Evans. A certificate of authenticity with product number (same as the serial number) will be included with each sheet. The acrylic packaging provides a good inert storage environment, which can be used for display and offers protection against movement without unnecessarily handling the Federation \$5 full sheets. Another packaging option is a cardboard cylinder.
- 1b. **Tender 2:** for sale are the 50 lowest numbered Federation \$5 note in folder products. The notes in the folder product have an overprint in RED of '1901-2001' and the first prefix of AA 01. The numerical part of the serial number ranges from 001 001 to 001 050. This selection of notes is consecutively numbered.
- 1c. **Tender 3:** for sale are Federation \$5 flat uncirculated notes with the first prefix of AA 01. These notes (only 492 available) will have low serial numbers beginning at 000 009 through to 000 500. This selection of notes is consecutively numbered.
2. Tenderers can bid for one or more products up to the total number available for sale. Tenderers can submit multiple bids for different quantities. Bids for specific serial numbers and bids for products within a range of numbers will also be accepted. Non-competitive bids will not be accepted. Bids are for the product exclusively of all delivery costs. Note Printing Australia Limited (NPA) reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
3. The highest bids for specific numbered products or for products from a range of product numbers will only be successful if such product numbers have not already been allocated to higher bids.
4. Oral tenders will not be accepted. Bids will only be accepted if received by mail before the deadline in writing, signed by or on behalf of the tenderer and accompanied by a bank cheque, personal cheque, bank draft, money order or Bankcard, MasterCard, Visa, Diners or Amex credit card authorisation and included in a sealed envelope addressed to NPA as set out in paragraph 9. (A tender by facsimile will not be accepted by NPA). Any of these forms of payment will only be processed if the bid is successful. Bids will be voided if funds are not available when the form of payment is processed. If any discrepancies are found, the applicant will be contacted and requested to furnish the required funds within a 48-hour period. Upon failure to do so, the product will then revert to the next applicant in line. All tenderers will be advised of success or otherwise. Cheques, bank drafts and money orders from unsuccessful tenderers will be returned. NPA will not be responsible for loss of these items in transit. Sealed envelopes will only be opened after the tender has closed.
5. Bids must be received by NPA before 4pm Australian Eastern Standard Time on Monday 21st May 2001 (the deadline).
6. Tenders received after the deadline will not be considered by NPA unless it can be clearly established to the satisfaction of NPA that the late receipt can be attributed to a fault of NPA.
7. Employees of the Reserve Bank of Australia/NPA and their immediate families are not eligible to tender. This invitation to tender is open to any other individual, firm or organisation in Australia or overseas.
8. Details of all bids received by NPA are confidential. NPA will not disclose the names of tenderers, but reserves the right to disclose the range of successful bids.
